- Old Testament:
Ecclesiastes 3:1
“To everything there is a season...”
 - New Testament (Support):
Luke 19:41-44
Jesus weeps because they missed their moment.
 - Epistle:
Ephesians 5:15-16
“Redeeming the time...”
Don't waste divine opportunities.

May 24th “ –A Right Now Anointing” (Pentecost Sunday)

Main Text: **2 Kings 2:9-11,**

2 Kings 13:20-21

- Old Testament:
– **Joel 2:28-29**
The promise of outpouring.
- New Testament (Support):
– **Acts 2:1-4**
The fulfillment—right now power.
- Epistle:
1 Corinthians 12:4-7
The anointing manifests for purpose.

May 31st “–It’s Official”

Main Text: **John 2:1-8**

- Old Testament:
Habakkuk 2:2-3
What God declares will come to pass.
- New Testament (Support):
Luke 1:37
“Nothing shall be impossible with God.”
- Epistle:

Philippians 1:6

What God starts—He finishes. That’s what makes it official.
